

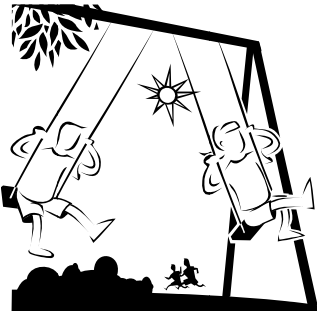

Summer for Preschool & Children Entering Kindergarten

Summers at Nativity are a time for the children to unwind from the school year while still being engaged in a fun and educational environment.



- Certain days are designated water play days and children change into their swimwear and run around in the sprinklers that are set up in the playground.
- We feature a different educational theme every week and the activities, songs and crafts are all centered around that unit.
- Visitors come in every few weeks to share exciting information with the kids, some visitors we've had in the past include: a travelling zoo, paint some pottery, a musician, a beekeeper, a creepy crawly critters demonstration, mini-movers, etc

Primary & School Age Summer

Summers at Nativity are a time for the children to unwind from the school year while still being engaged in a fun and educational environment. There are three different sessions offered each summer with field trips that correspond with each theme. Journals are utilized weekly in order to promote creative writing skills. Children enjoy scheduled silent reading time to cool off after coming in from outside. Typically we read chapter books aloud and incorporate art projects and multimedia comparisons related to the chosen books. Some themes from past summers are listed below as a taste of what we might do.



- Coal & Energy
 - Eckley Miner's Village, Asa Packer Mansion, Jim Thorpe Old Jail House, Pioneer Tunnel Coal Mine/Steam Train
- Nativity Olympics
 - Lehigh Valley Sports Academy, Iron Pigs Game, Olympics (bowling, javelin, softball toss, puzzle contest, bean bag toss, obstacle course, steeple chase - running, biggest splash at the pool, mini golf, long jump, soccer kick)
- Health & Nutrition
 - Local Chefs, Growing our own Garden, cooking with our veggies, Ice Cream Lab (Ice Cream Around the World), Swimming

Children go on two field trips per week, one is educational and is tied into the theme of the week, the other is more geared toward physical activity (bowling, mini-golf, swimming).



Creativity is encouraged during free choice time. In the past children have decided to make home movies, mini talent shows for the little kids in preschool, and even a restaurant where they made menus and décor for their eatery!

We run a Fun Fitness class for the kids to get their blood pumping once a week with fun and silly workouts set to music.



A Typical Summer Day

7:00-10:00am	Free Choice (Wii, computers, board games, dramatic play, Nintendo DS time, blocks and manipulatives, etc)
10:00am	Snack (provided)
10:30am	Outside if weather permitting (jungle gym, dodge ball, jump ropes, swings, sandbox, scooters, basketball hoops, kickball, etc) OR Field Trip (times vary)
11:30am	Teacher reads aloud to group
12:00pm	Nutritional hot lunch (provided)
12:30pm	Free reading time/ journals
1:00pm	Free choice or Weekly Theme Activities
3:00pm	Snack (provided)
3:30-6:00pm	Outside if weather permitting



Program Options for Summer 2018
